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## Lip Sync Battle Guidelines

- 1. Team Size:** Teams can range in size from 1 - 10 people. All team members must be included on the registration form. Only individuals listed on the registration form can perform. Individuals can only compete in one act.
- 2. Props:** Teams are encouraged to use props; these props must be included on the registration form to be approved by the Wonderfeet Kids Museum Events Committee. You are in charge of getting your props on and off stage and will have 30 seconds at the start and end of your song to set up and break down your act. Your team will be expected to provide your own props, if you choose to use any. They must be delivered to the Paramount the morning of the event to be ready for dress rehearsal and must be taken home immediately following the event.
- 3. Music:** Music selection must be submitted to be approved by the Wonderfeet Kids Museum Events Committee by **March 10th**. Songs must be the clean version; no explicit versions will be accepted. Failure to submit music may result in the team's registration being canceled. If you need help editing/ mixing music, please let us know and we can help support. All music must be submitted to the committee and the Paramount tech team by April 14th.
- 4. Time Limit:** The maximum time permitted for your performance is four minutes. After four minutes the music will fade out. Mash-ups and edited songs are suggested.
- 5. Appropriateness:** The Wonderfeet Kids Museum Committee reserves the right to cancel registration if the committee feels the act is inappropriate or offensive to others. If an offensive act is performed the Committee reserves the right to terminate the performance and the act will be disqualified.
- 6. Coaches:** Teams can have the assistance of a dance/ performance coach of their choosing. Please indicate above if you're interested in being assigned a coach.
- 7. Practice Space:** Please let organizers know if you need assistance with finding practice space.
- 8. Intro Video:** We will be filming each team for a short interview during their practice session to use to introduce each team during the show. We will work with you to coordinate a time for the videographer to attend.
- 9. Ticket Sales:** There is no requirement for teams to purchase tickets. However, we do encourage you to get the word out to friends, family and community members - ticket proceeds benefit the Museum, and help your team's chances of winning the Fan Favorite Award!
- 10. Event Promotion:** All team members participating allow for pictures or videos of their practice or other team events to be used for promotional material in print or social media as promotion for this event.

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## Judging Criteria

- A. Lip Sync Abilities: How well the performer(s) lip sync the lyrics of the song.
- B. Creativity: How original and creative the performance is. Instead of just standing on stage lip-syncing a song - props, choreography, costumes, and/or other ideas should be used. Be creative!
- C. Stage Presence and Choreography: Again, don't just stand there. Engage the audience, dance, smile, make eye contact. You're a star! Have fun!
- D. Audience Favorite

Each category will be worth 15 points each. In case of a tie the act with the highest lip sync score will win. The judges' decisions are final.
